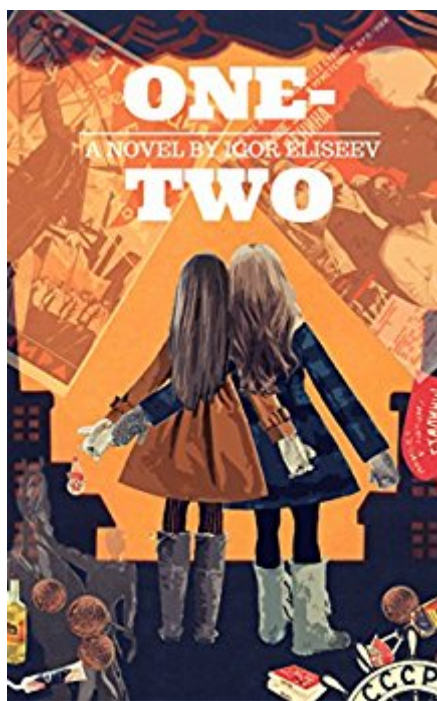

Synopsis

One-Two by Russian author, Igor Eliseev is quite a fascinating novel and one of the more soul-stirring books I've read in a long time. Set in Russia in the 1980s and 1990s, the period of Perestroika, it's a psychological drama that revolves around two conjoined twins named Faith and Hope. Born in a maternity home, they are placed in an institution for foster children where they spend much of their childhood. The story is narrated, for the most part, by Faith, evidently the physically stronger of the twins. Through her thoughts and feelings and her interactions with the other wards in the home and the staff, we get to see and feel the pain and trauma the twins are subjected to on account of the negativity of those around them, some of whom view them as subhuman. They suffer non-stop verbal and emotional abuse, humiliation and even hatred from young and old alike, all because they are viewed as different from a "normal" human beings. In a touching moment of reflection, Hope laments the realization that "in their eyes, we are not the poor cripples deserving compassion but the two-headed freaks invoking fear and disgust." With no one to turn to for support, the twins are forced to depend on each other for solace in order not to surrender completely to despair. Notwithstanding its depressing overtones, One-Two is by no means a dark tale of misery and hopelessness. At some point a ray of hope flickers and the opportunity for the twins to have their condition corrected through surgery presents itself. But first they have to overcome more obstacles. At the same time they are conflicted about the possible ramifications of being separated from each other and how it is likely to affect their lives. One-Two is quite a moving and inspiring tale.
