

The Year She Left Us is a beautifully written debut book about the lives of three generations of Chinese American women who are bonded together by love and loss. The book is told through alternating chapters by Charlie and her daughter Ari, with a few carefully interwoven chapters from Les and Gran. A single woman, Charlie Kong longs for a baby and against the advice of her older sister and mother travels to an orphanage in China to adopt. Charlie names her baby Ariadne (Ari for short) and delights in her motherhood. Ari is given all the love she could ever need by the Kong family of women. Charlie is a kind soul who lives her life doing for others. She is a public defender, and after the abrupt ending of a serious relationship devotes herself to her daughter and family. Les, her confident older sister is a judge hoping for a federal magistrate position. Their mother Gran, is well educated, outspoken and family oriented. Like Ari, she was born in China and has not come to terms with heartbreak in her own past. "The future holds promise while the past is full of ghosts. "Charlie is convinced that Ari will have it easier as an adopted child, as she can decide later if she wants to inform others that she was adopted. Charlie makes a lifelong friend in Robyn, who she meets when traveling to the orphanage in Kunming, her daughter named Asia Jade (A.J) also becomes Ari's best friend. A.J. is adopted into a white Jewish family and never looks back at her parentage. Ari, as Gran lets the reader know "looked back, a fatal error. She never should have visited the orphanage full of bad associations"Ari's feelings of of abandonment culminates in her total withdrawal from her family after she and A.J.
