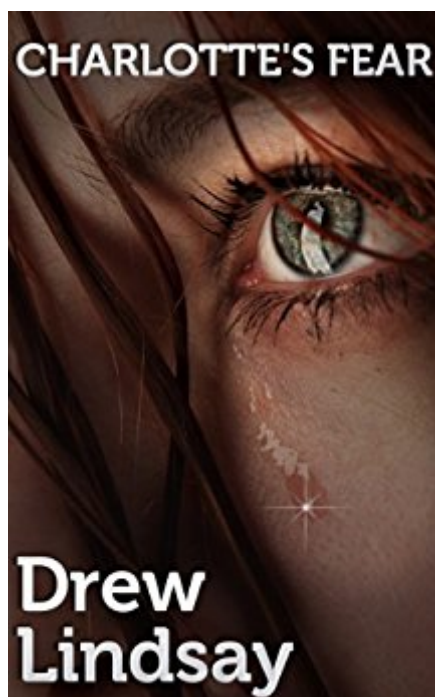

Not much of a plot; the book could have been a short story, but it was expanded to book length with a lot of filler such as a description of a wedding and a vacation in Bora Bora. Lindsay can sure churn them out as "Treasure" was just published a couple of months ago, but this one could have used some more plotting. I hope the use of filler does not portend future books, as I have noticed in other popular authors (eg Grafton, Muller, Cornwell, Paretsky), the books get thicker as time goes by, but less interesting.
