

I was expecting more for a textbook that costs so much. The theory presented in the book wasn't very clear or very detailed. In our class, I ended up learning more from a free CDC PDF file that was more clear. We hardly used the textbook in our class- outside materials were more clear.

Badly-written, slanted, and without scientific corroboration of the author's grandiose declarations. At times it sounds more like a diatribe. The author falls for an attitude you find sometimes in the field of public health - "medical doctors are the devil and public health practitioners are the salvation of the universe". Ugh. This book should have been edited rigorously by a professional before being published. Where I went to school, we had to use this textbook because the author is a professor in that department. I guess the teachers who taught the intro class were afraid to use something else, or maybe they drank the diatribe Kool-Aid too. To understand the subject, please buy yourself another book.
