Katie Lovely is a Rubenesque high school teacher, somewhere in her late twenties. Shy and lacking self confidence, Katie loves to teach and bake. After signing her class up for an Adopt-a-Marine pen pal project, Katie finds herself one student short. What to do but adopt Sergeant Major Mark Gunner

as her own Marine - it's the right thing to do. Sergeant Major Mark Gunner, forty-something and a complete hunk, is serving in Yemen. It's the last tour of his military career. A lone wolf, Mark is happily surprised when he receives Katie Lovely's letter. A correspondence ensues between Mark and Katie that rapidly escalates into some serious heat. Add into this mix shipments of Katie's homemade chocolate chip cookies and Sergeant Gunner can't wait to come face-to-face with the lovely Miss Lovely and her delectable cookies. P. S. . . You're Mine is a very short Valentine novella by team Alexa Riley. As with many of their stories, P. S. . . You're Mine is focused on the Alpha male insta-loving his virgin mate. It takes a while for the action between Mark and Katie to happen, but when it does, it's of the vanilla, hot-to-breed variety. Much of this story is centered around the correspondence between Mark and Katie, and while it's good, the concept of insta-love via snail mail just didn't work for this reader. Perhaps Sergeant Gunner caught a whiff of Miss Lovely's pheromones on the envelope flaps Note: P. S. . . You're Mine is erotica written for a specific, targeted audience. It is meant to stimulate and arouse a bedtime/good-time tale for the grown-ups, not the kiddies. Three and 1/2 stars ARC provided from the author for an honest review.

The plots for the two holiday novellas were fine, but the writing was pretty flat, and the first-person narration (from multiple perspectives) seemed wooden. Also, what is up with the whole virgin-agrees-to-unprotected-sex-without-hesitation-and-gets-pregnant-on-the-first-try storyline? It is present in both novellas. And the stalking elements in the second (Christmas-themed) story "Snow and Mistletoe" freaked me out. If he---1) hires someone to monitor your activities 2) hires you to record audiobooks but then never sells those recordings--instead choosing to keep them for himself and masturbate to them 3) lives alone in a desolate cabin in the woods 4) simply announces that he has no intention of ever putting a "barrier" between the two of you during sex--I would personally run.
